The CCP *Training Tracker* is an uncomplicated way to manage your necessary 150 clock hours of validated training. It has been designed to assist the Candidate and Field Counselor in the following ways:

- Determining training needs for each Professional Ability Area
- Tracking and compiling training hours
- Identifying the Professional Ability Areas which may need additional training to achieve the necessary 15 clock hours of training.
- A minimum of fifteen clock hours of training is required for each Professional Ability Area. These clock hours may be chosen from a variety of options. Some options are, but not limited to:

  - Post-Secondary School Courses
  - Junior College Courses
  - o Extended University Courses
  - o Education from Professional Associations
